Be it enacted by Parliament in the Twenty-second year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Constitution (Amend-

ment) Act, 1971. 5 (2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

2. In the Seventh Schedule

(i) in List II—State be omitted;

(ii) in List III-Concurrent List, after entry 25, the following new entry shall be inserted, namely:—
