- (1) Border Road Task Force may continue to follow the existing procedures of registering the labourers imported by themselves and issue of Identity cards etc.
- (2) The other Contractors for bringing labourers will obtain permission from the Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl Dist and register the names of labourers imported with particulars by the contractors concerned after their physical arrival. Prior permission of the Deputy Commissioner, Aizawl District will serve as permit for entering into Mizoram.
