 - (viii) liquified petroleum gas
 - (ix) lubricants and greaces including base oils;
 - . (x) wax of all grades;
 - (xi) bitumen
 - (xii) solvents of all types including mineral turpentine oil;
 - (xiii) all other products manufactured out of crude oil:
- (g) "Schedule" means a Schedule appended to this Order,
- (h) "Supply Area" specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule means the area specified in the corresponding entrues up column 2 of that Schedule.

2. In this Order "Kerosine" shall have the meaning sesigned to Definition. it in item No. 7 of the First Schedule to the Central Excise and Sait Act, 1844 (1 of 1844) and shall not include Aviation Turbine Fuel.

Restriction 3. No person shall use or consume kerosine for any purpose tion on use—other than cooking or illumination or both, of kerosine

- Exception 4. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this order, a State-Government or any authority nominated by it may by special order permit any person to use kerosine for such purpose as it may consider to be essential.
 - (2) Nothing in this order shall apply to the use of kerosine for any purpose by the Armed Forces of the Union.
